

Lodging Policy for Insulin Dependent Diabetic Pets

At **Valley Animal Hospital** we take the care of all our boarding pets very seriously; however diabetic pets require more careful monitoring and a few extra precautions than typical boarders.

When a diabetic pet is boarding, their response to insulin may be significantly different from that at home. The insulin needs of diabetic pets can change based on several factors including stress, daily exercise and the amount of food eaten at each meal. All of these factors can fluctuate while your pet is boarding.

While boarding with **Valley Animal Hospital**, your pet will receive daily blood glucose monitoring. This allows us to provide the best medical care and safest boarding environment for your diabetic pet.

In addition to boarding fees, a daily Diabetic Pet Care fee of \$55.00 will be charged. This fee will cover blood glucose monitoring and administration of your pet's insulin.

If it becomes evident that your pet requires more intensive monitoring, we will make every effort to contact you. If we are unable to contact you, your pet WILL BE TREATED at your expense.

I understand the above and accept financial responsibility for any monitoring the veterinarian(s) of **Valley Animal Hospital** recommends to ensure my pet's well-being while boarding.
